DEPARTMENT OF RETURNEES AND IDPs

CCRI will target 75,000 IDPs from Khorflus, 45,000 from Khartoum, 30,000 in Ethiopia, and other resettling returnees and IDPs from Malakal, Costi, Uganda, and Kenya in 2008. This project funded by USAID direct and the provisions of food and distribution will be through World Food Program. Provision of non-food materials and displacement kits will be through UNICEIF and NPA. Drilling of water at resettlement sites will be through CCRI funding by USAID/PACT Sudan.

CCRI-Sudan aims at resettling displaced populations; it will therefore assess becoming situations of both the internally and externally displaced persons and develop appropriately responsive intervention strategies:

- A) Food and non-food needs assessment
- B) Water and Sanitation
- C) Health Care
- D) Social structures
- E) Logistic arrangements
- F) Resettlement through setting up Low income houses etc
- G) Provision of Primary Education
